

The only reason that preaching and baptizing (Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-16; Luke 24:46-47) are of any importance is because Jesus rose from the dead. Rising from the waters of baptism reflects how "Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father" (Romans 6:1-10). Jesus defeated death so that we can live with Him if we remain faithful to Him.

The resurrection of Jesus Christ is the foundation of the Christian faith.
