


Many signs and wonders were done by the apostles—

Salvation to everyone who believes (Romans 1:16-21). Do you believe?



Who “is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation?” (Colossians 1)

Faith secures salvation: a faith that abounds by adding and maturing Christian grace enables a person to make their “calling an election sure: for if you do these things you will never stumble” (1 Peter 1:10). The “obedience of faith” (Romans 16:26) permits a person to have constant “access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God” (Romans 5:2). Such a faith is walking in the light of truth “and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin” (1 John 1:7).

God’s love, grace, and mercy manifested in the cross is our only hope. It is the blood of Christ that washes away sins (Revelation 1:5); that enables us to enjoy “remission of sins” (Matthew 26:28); that permits us to draw near to God (Ephesians 2:13); that obtains by special means our redemption (Hebrews 9:12); that allows us to be reconciled to God (Ephesians 2:16); and that saves us from the wrath of God (Romans 5:9). The appropriation of these blessings of grace is enjoyed when we submit to God’s will in the “obedience of faith” (Romans 16:26). Salvation is reserved for “all them that obey Him” (Hebrews 5:9).

Do you have in your possession a “faith that secures salvation?”
